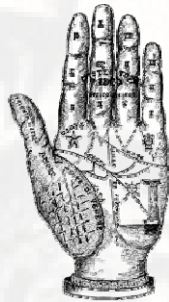
Susan B. Anthony: Failure is Impossible

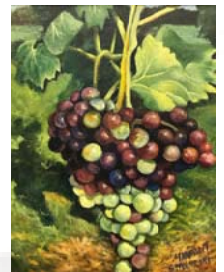

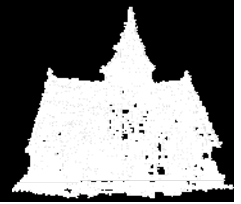

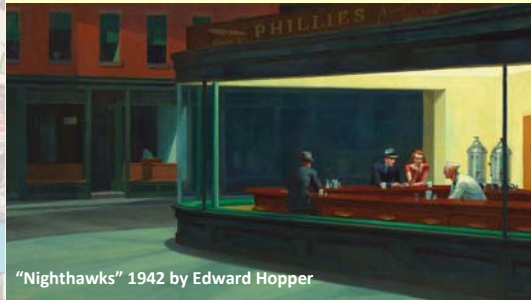
